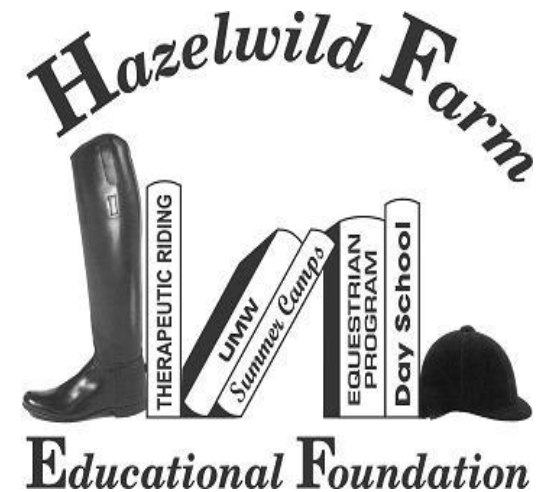


**Level 3:** Instruction on equitation fundamentals at the walk, trot, and canter, including leads and diagonals. Some instruction over poles and small jumps. The student must be able to post the trot and canter safely in a small group prior to enrollment in Level 3.

**Level 4:** Instruction on more sophisticated equitation fundamentals on the flat. Instruction over small jumps progressing to short courses. The student must be able to demonstrate knowledge and performance of correct leads and diagonals prior to enrollment in Level 4. The student must also demonstrate a safe and secure position for jumping prior to enrollment in Level 4.

**Level 5:** Instruction for students currently showing, or interested in showing, in 2' divisions or higher. The student must be able to safely jump a course of small jumps prior to enrollment in Level 5.

**Note:** Parents are encouraged to watch their child's lesson from the outside of the ring. **PARENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER THE RING OR COACH YOUR CHILD FROM THE OUTSIDE OF THE RING. This causes a safety hazard for everyone in the lesson.** Parents with other children may be asked to leave if the other children are creating a disturbance.

## THE RIDING SCHOOL

Hazelwild Farm will offer a **ten (10)** week Fall Fundamental Riding Series. Classes will begin Saturday, September 4, 2010. Please arrive 15 minutes early to tack up your mount. Class space is limited due to ability, availability of suitable mounts and help available. The class times are as follows:

Monday	5:00-6:00	Level 1
	6:00-7:00	Level 3
Tuesday	5:30-6:30	Level 4/5
Wednesday	4:30-5:30	Level 2
Saturday	9:00-10:00	Level 2
	10:00-11:00	Level 3

Saturday lessons may see a different instructor on a weekly basis due to the horse show commitments of the instructors.

### COST

The 10 lesson series will cost \$350.00. **A \$175.00 deposit is due upon registration. The remaining \$175.00 is due no later than October 9, 2010. Please write "Fall Community" on the memo line of your check.** Please see the insert for the registration process.

One make-up lesson OR one lesson refund will be allowed in the event of student cancellation. \$50.00 will be charged for all returned checks.

### CANCELLATIONS

Classes **WILL NOT** carry over from one series to another. The make-up lessons will be scheduled the week of November 15-17, 2010. Upon sign up, you will be given a list of all of your lesson dates including the make-up lesson date. If you have not missed a lesson and there is room in a make-up lesson, you may pay \$35.00 to be in the make-up lesson.

If you know you are going to miss a lesson, please call us in advance (891-7101). This will prevent horses being left in the barn needlessly.

### SHOWING

On Saturday, November 20, 2010, an informal horse show will be held for participants in the Fall Fundamental Riding Series. There will be a \$25.00 charge for the horse show. Details on the show will be given to participants and their parents toward the end of the lesson series.

Anyone interested in doing our regular horse shows, please talk to Chelsie to see if and when your child is ready.

### EQUIPMENT

All students must wear boots with a heel and an **ASTM /SEI Certified Riding Helmet** with a harness. **Students who do not have either appropriate foot wear or helmets will not be allowed to ride in their lesson.** Both of these items may be purchased at Double L Tack Shop (371-2250) or Snow Hill Farm (540 582-5431). In addition, all students must wear pants to ride.

### LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

**Level 1:** Fundamentals on grooming, tacking and untacking. Hunt Seat Equitation fundamentals at the walk and trot.

**Level 2:** Further instruction on grooming, tacking and untacking, as well as equitation fundamentals at the walk, trot and canter including diagonals. The student must be able to demonstrate a posting trot prior to enrollment in Level 2.
